GENERAL JOB DESCRIPTION

The Conservation Authority Water Resources Engineer is responsible for the identification, development and maintenance of the water resources and hazard land information system of the Conservation Authority. Responsibilities include providing technical expertise to staff, municipalities and other stakeholders in regard to Ontario Regulation 177/06 on acceptable management practices and forms of development that will ensure protection of property and life within the watershed. This expertise will result from the ongoing completion and upgrading of watershed technical studies and planning projects that the Water Resource Engineer will coordinate or lead.
